# 9/11 in Global Context

September 11, 2021 marks the 20th anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks on New York and Washington, DC. While it is important to commemorate this event, it is also important to understand 9/11 in a broader global context. What were the causes of 9/11, and what have been the lasting effects?

The WCU community aims to remember the event without reinforcing the stereotypical connection between Islam and terrorism. WCU honors those who lost their lives in this event and its aftermath—not only US citizens and soldiers, but also Afghan, Iraqi, and other allies and civilians who have been killed or displaced in the 20 years since 9/11.






